

## Seeking interviewers for a study on interpreting in law enforcement interviews

Do you have experience obtaining witness statements? Do you want to learn how to work with a non-English speaking witness? If so, we want you to participate in a study of interpreting in law enforcement interviews.

Free of charge, you will receive online training on working with interpreters and best practice interviewing techniques from leading international experts.

You will conduct an interview via zoom with a witness who observed a neighbourhood incident on video. If the witness does not speak English, the interview will be attended by a professional interpreter. The interview should last about 15 minutes, although interpreted interviews may take longer.

After the interview, you will receive a certificate of continuing professional development and copies of tips on working with interpreters and Mendez principles.
